Getting to know you:

1. What was the worst breakup or job loss you've experienced?
2. Looking back at the sermon from this week's teaching, was there anything you heard for the first time, caught your attention, was reminded of or was a big takeaway for you?
3. Take a few minutes and read aloud 1 Peter 4:7-11

Getting into the text:

4. Read 1 Peter 4:7. What does Peter mean by saying the end is near?
 1. Do you believe one day, the world as we know it will end?
 2. What does it mean to be both alert and sober-minded? Why is this important today?
5. Read 1 Peter 4:8-9 What barriers keep us from loving as Jesus loved?
 1. Do you believe love covers a multitude of sins? Why or why not?
 2. What does constant love look like in your daily walk with God and others?
 3. Define what it means to be Hospitable?
 4. Do you find yourself complaining more or less these days?
6. Read 1 Peter 4:10. What gifts have God graced your life with and why?
 1. Do you find yourself operating under the grace of God or your strength?
 2. How is God most glorified in your life?
