Getting into the text:

4. Reading 2 Peter 1:19 What comes to your mind when you hear the word prophetic?
 1. Peter clearly states that the word of God is prophetic, what is the writer's intent by this descriptor?
 2. The statements light shining, day dawning and morning star are used for what purpose?
5. Reading verse 20, if Peter is not delivering his own thoughts and words then how should we, interpret this verse and why?
 1. This text state "no prophecy of scripture" points us to what truth concerning the word of God?
6. Read verse 21 a few times and discuss what stands out to you in this text.
 1. Where does the word of God originate from and why is this important?
 2. Peter mentions the role of the Holy Spirit as it relates to inspiration, what does it mean that the Bible is inspired by God?
 3. Do you believe that the Bible is God's inspired word to mankind? Why or why not?
 4. Read 2 Timothy 3:16 and 2 Peter 1:20-21 how do the scriptures give credence to each other?
