2 Peter 2:6-10
(Week of May 14, 2023)

Getting to know you:

1. Why are so many people drawn to those in culture that oppose truth?
2. Looking back at the sermon from this week's teaching, was there anything you heard for the first time, caught your attention, was reminded of, or was a big takeaway for you?
3. Take a few minutes and read aloud 2 Peter 2:1-10

Getting into the text:

4. Reading 2 Peter 2:5-10 Discuss what it looks like to fully trust God in our current world.

1. Peter states that God rewarded Noah for taking a stand against the culture of his day. Why is it important to be reminded about how God dealt with Noah and those who opposed his warnings?

(See Genesis 7 and 8)

2. In what ways are people still listening to false prophets despite the biblical warning today?

3. Peter using the wrath that fell on Sodom and Gomorrah as an example of what will happen to the ungodly that reject God's way of living. (See Genesis 13:12-13)

How do we warn people about the wrath of God that awaits those in our time that reject Jesus?

Do you believe in a literal Hell as a place of eternal damnation? Will God judge and hold accountable all who reject Jesus as Lord? What does it mean to watch our lives and warn others?

4. Read Jude 1:17-23 and discuss what are the faithful promises we should hold too and how should we respond today to those deceived by evil people and help naive people?

5. Read 2 Peter 2:9-10 Where should our hope be as faithful followers of Christ based on these verses?

1. How will God deliver His people from the allure of the ungodly? (See 1 Corinthians 10:13)
